## **Lake Norfolk Boat Poker Run Rules & Regulations**

To avoid confusion and disappointment, it is important to understand the ground rules for the Lake Norfolk Boat Poker Run:

- \* Although this is a "run", there are no prizes for speed - it does not matter who is first to complete the course. It is not a race. Please maintain all boating laws and remember to slow down when coming into coves.
- \* The winning hand is determined by **standard poker hand rankings**. It should be clear whether five or seven cards can be used to build the winning hand, there will not be any "wild cards" allowed, and players are allowed to buy extra cards at any point during the "run". They will be available only at Jordan Marina or during preregistration. Extra hands can be purchased for an additional \$25.
- \* There will be one deck of cards at each "port of call", participants will be allowed to draw their own cards.
- \* If a player draws a hand that they already have. This is a situation which never occurs in "real life" poker, **and it will not be allowed to happen on the Lake Norfolk Boat Poker Run either**. The reason is simple - poker hand rankings are based on the likelihood of each hand occurring, and if duplicate cards are allowed the probabilities of a given hand change. It becomes easier to get four of a kind if you are allowed to have two of the King of Hearts in your hand for example. If this happens, the player will re-draw any cards that are duplicates. For example, if you draw the seven of clubs and you already have the seven of clubs on your score card, then you must put the card back and re-draw another card.
- \* Each participant must have a **poker score sheet / card**, and this must be filled in by the organizers, not by the participant. It is the participants' responsibility to check their score sheet before leaving each checkpoint, to ensure that the card they drew is correctly recorded on their score sheet.
- \* **Score sheets will be presented as rows and columns**, with the rank and suits of cards clearly visible. Organizers will then count across the rows and columns in a matter of seconds to clearly see pairs, flushes and straights as patterns on the score sheet.
- \* Proceeds from this event go to benefit the Norfolk Lake Chamber of Commerce. Donations are accepted.
- \* **All preregistered/paid participants will be allowed to set off from their "home" dock as long as it is a participating "Port of Call". Pre-Registration materials will be available with Poker Run volunteers.**
